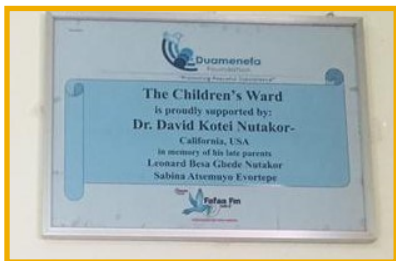
DUAMENEFA VOLUNTEER MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION

As of 31 December 2022 we have 29,682 members; 99% which live in the Volta Region, has increased again over 7,000 during 2022. People desire peace in their communities. Two registrations at various communities take place most weeks and everyone from chiefs, police, immigration, teachers, traders, fetish priests, pastors and more are coming. We are grateful to God for this huge work and look for 40,000 people to join by the end of 2023. The benefits are a community supporting peace, eligibility to participate in fun games, which are community-based competitions to bring the people together for fun and unity building.

SUPPORT TO KETA MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL CHILDREN'S WARD

Glory to God!

- Duamenefa Foundation is giving back to the birthplace of both Dr. David Kotei Nutakor and Mr. Emmanuel Ketaman Evortepe, the CEO of Fafaa and Executive President of Duamenefa Foundation.
- Dr. David, in honoring his late parents, felt he wanted to adopt the children's ward and do some major work there. So in December of 2019, he began by donating a 65" plasma TV with satellite hookups for the children. That was followed by a complete painting of the ward inside and out, then curtains were made to brighten up the place.
- In 2021, 20 high-density student mattresses were donated for the parents of children to sleep on when having to stay over, next renovation of a small exam room into a play/learning room for the children.
- In 2022, much needed adult and baby scales and strong plastic chairs to help the nurses do their job well were given to the ward. A C-PAP machine was considered however the one priced was not acceptable, so we are revisiting this request with acceptable models.



The Executive President of Duamenefa Foundation, Mr. Emmanuel Ketaman Evortepe desired to help the male ward by first gifting four-32" televisions with satellite hookup to keep the men engaged in the news affairs while healing.

Next the hospital recognized the need in this ward to help prevent covid, so three automatic hand dryers, four touchless sanitizer dispensers, 120 hand towels and bottles of sanitizer were delivered during the first quarter of 2021.

The ward received room dividers, thermometers, stethoscopes and rolling medicine trays then two hospital beds with mattresses were given.
