DEVELOPMENT OF YOUTH AND SPORTS

The Duamenefa Foundation since 2017 has initiated the development of youth and sports to unearth the hidden talents embedded in the youth of the Volta Region and to market same to the international community.

It was during our second year finale, in 2018, that the Regional Director of Sports of the National Sports Authority, Volta Region, Mr. Amponfi, Jr. was invited to our finale. He came with others and was so impressed with the organization, he pronounced

the Duamenefa Gala and Marathon a regional tournament putting it on the National football schedule.

In the year 2019, 104 football teams competed in the regional tournament lasting for five full months. The competition was very tight, but the winners emerged successfully celebrating at the grand finale with over 30,000 spectators and dignitaries. The day was also a time the the Duamenefa Foundation was officially outdoored.

The pandemic had put a halt

to the tournament for two years, but today the players, coaches and spectators are preparing for the kickoff weekend, 7th of May 2022. Sixty (60) football clubs will be participating in the tournament.



Single Parents / Free Health Screening ...

A Free Health Screening took place at the premises of Fafaa 100.3 FM, Dzodze during a Seminar for Single Parents, given by Pastor Adefunke Ayeove of Treasure of His Eves. UK. an associate NGO of Duamenefa Foundation. Medical staffers numbering 10 came from St. Anthony's Hospital, Dzodze to do the screening.

Over 230 people came to receive a word of encouragement and lessons for Single Parents then received the free health check.

The same week in Keta, presentations of sewing machines and professional hairdryers were made to six trained single parents to empower them to care well for their families.

We thank God for the life of Pastor Adeoye for her heart of love for Single Parents.
