## UPDATE ON THE DUAMENEFA FOUNDATION VOCATION SCHOOL

It is difficult to wait an entire quarter to share the great work that is ongoing and how God has blessed our efforts.

The classroom block consisting of six large classrooms now has a foundation and each classroom is being filled readying them for cement floors. A very labor intense effort, but it is important for the next steps.

After floors are poured then begins raising up the walls to lintel then roofing levels.

The classroom is the first building of five with the hostel where the students will live scheduled next.

Big steps must be taken to get the school ready for the students and staff (some of who will reside on the school premises).

### OUR POTENTIAL STUDENTS

Our students will need much from us, both physically and spiritually.

Because our wards are coming out of very abusive and hopeless situations with fearful threats of madness or death constantly over their heads, the love of God will be most important to see them through to complete healing and wholeness. Teaching them an employable skill is secondary to this. With man, it is impossible, but we know what the Word of God says and He will set them free in Jesus' Name.

God desires all captives free in body, mind and spirit; free of fear and intimidation and safe in the arms of God.

We will begin interviewing the applicants we have in the next few months for we believe we will open in September 2022.

### Where we are in the process?

#### Done:

- Location of land
- Land transfer
- Molding of blocks (5000 done)
- Drawings (draft, elevations, site plan)
- Submission of Elevations to Municipality for approval and building permits (granted)
- Spiritual Ground breaking with much prayer, intercession and praise to God
- Marking and digging of classroom block foundations
- Pouring foundation
- Bending rods for pillar reinforcement
- Building of foundation
- Installing rods for pillars

#### Work in Process

- Filling in the classrooms with filler dirt to be able to pour cement floors
- Raising of walls to lintel then roofing levels

### Big items needed during the classroom work and before the hostel is built.

- Roofing for the classroom
- Borehole for fresh potable water (\$2,900-\$3,000)
- Septic tank
